Zumbathon: Wednesday, May 13, 2015 from 6pm-7:30pm to benefit Complete My Plate. \$10 admission. Kids 12 and younger are free. North Side Gym, 501 Orchard Ave., Ellwood City. Complete My Plate is a new program within the Ellwood City School District that provides healthy food on weekends for more than 50 hungry students, identified by school faculty and staff. Non-perishable items are placed discreetly in the students' backpacks on Fridays so they will be able to eat on Saturdays and Sundays. The bulk of the funding comes through the Community Foundation of Western PA and Eastern OH but foundation members ask to see communities come together to support the program. This Zumbathon is Ellwood's first attempt to raise the funds to feed our hungriest students. The program is also known as the Ellwood City School District Breadbasket Program or simply the backpack program.
